# WANGANUI JOCKEY CLUB WIN \$ 2000 ! PUNTER OF THE YEAR 2022 Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> April RULES AND CONDITIONS

- All contestants must be registered by 5pm Friday 29 April 2022 to be included. Entries will only be accepted on a 'first come basis', unless by prior arrangement. The Wanganui Jockey Club reserves the right to allow late entries to the competition if space allows.
- 2. Employees of the WJC and any persons under the age of 18 are not eligible to enter this competition.
- 3. Name of contestants to be disclosed although a Pseudonym (nom de plume) may be used for publicity purposes. Teams of up to 4 persons. One of the team <u>must</u> have a current TAB account or at least ID for AML requirements.
- 4. \$600 being the betting fund together with \$40.00 per person entry fee is to be paid to the Club prior to raceday or in cash, on the morning of the race meeting.
- 5. Minimum of \$75.00 to be invested on <u>each</u> race commencing with race one. There is no maximum. There are no fixed odds bets permitted in the competition.
- 6. If contestant runs out of funds, no additional funds can be added.
- 7. If the balance is less than \$75.00, the entire amount shall be invested.
- 8. Entry to the Punter Competition Area will be restricted. There is a maximum of four persons per entry at \$40.00 per person which includes a buffet lunch & dessert, a complimentary drink and a Punters Pack.
- 9. All bets to be placed on the Wanganui Jockey Club's race meeting only & entrants must bet on every race.
- 10. There are NO Pick Six, Place 6, Fixed Odds or multi betting allowed.
- 11. All bets must be made at the club's totes and not via Wi-Fi or internet.
- 12. Each betting transaction must start and finish with a deposit betting voucher. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

- 13. It is the contestant's responsibility to ensure their investments are placed on time. No claims for incorrect or lost tickets will be considered as part of the competition.
- 14. It is a condition of entry that the onus to check tickets remains with the contestant. Neither the WJC nor the NZRB has any liability to acknowledge tickets which contestants' claim are incorrect.
- 15. The top ten place getters will be updated after each race and displayed on the scoreboard as soon as possible after results are confirmed.
- 16. In the event of an inquiry, which is not resolved prior to five minutes before the start of the following race, any contestant who has funds to reinvest on that race due to the inquiry, shall not be disqualified but shall resume investing on the race after the inquiry is complete – contact the organiser or MC.
- 17. The winner shall be the contestant with the highest balance after the dividends are declared for the last race and have been added to the contestants' deposit ticket.
- 18. In the event of a tie, the prize money will be shared equally between all tied contestants.
- 19. If in the event the race meeting is postponed, abandoned, or any other reason which impedes the competition, the club reserves the right to move the competition to another meeting(s).
- 20. All contestants will be given their deposit tickets at the commencement of the day in the Punters Competition Room following identification.
- 21. Competitors deposit tickets are individually coded and must be presented to the tote operator before any bets are entered.
- 22. Contestants must check their betting tickets after each bet.
- 23. If in case of a late scratching the amount of investment needs to be reinvested in the following race plus the race minimum.
- 24. Maximum number of entries is 100.
- 25. The Club reserves the right to cancel the competition if less than 50 entries are received.
- 26. The winner will be announced as soon as possible after the declaration of the last race.
- 27. The individual balance and payout of amounts earned will be available as soon as possible after the last race is confirmed. Every endeavour to pay out

final funds in cash will be made, however contestants must accept that either TAB cheques or deposit slips may have to be given.

- 28. If any entrant does not adhere to any of these rules and conditions they will be disqualified.
- 29. Any decisions made by the Wanganui Jockey Club are final; no discussion will be entered into.

#### PLEASE REMEMBER:

- A TAB trace will ensure that each contestant has abided by these Rules.
- You must present your deposit ticket & betting slip to the operator before any bets or collects are made.
- You must bet a minimum of \$75 on each race.
- You must check your tickets.
- You must retain your deposit ticket at all times.

**From 1<sup>st</sup> August 2019** the TAB will need to comply with the Anti-Money Laundering and Countering Financing of Terrorism Act 2009. Under this Act the TAB will need to know more about customers that bet or collect \$1000 or more.

Our Punter of the Year (POTY) competition and betting syndicates are subject to this legislation. When you register your team in the POTY, the syndicate's principal member undertaking this role will need a TAB betting account. If the member does not have an account then ID will be required to enable the TAB to issue a 'Punters Pass'.

Acceptable ID for a Punters Pass is:

- Passport or Firearms license + proof of address or;
- Drivers license + bank card + proof of address

The syndicate's principal member needs to be aware that each time he/she bets or collects \$1000 or more will need to provide their TAB account/Punters Pass number and PIN.
